An Evening with Isla St Clair



Isla is from the north-east of Scotland and is one of Britain's foremost traditional singers, noted for the depth of feeling she brings to our country's music. At the age of twelve she recorded the first of many traditional ballads for the School of Scottish Studies and these are still used as reference works. Still in her teens, Isla was soon in the top rank of British folksingers, winning several awards including 'Best Female Folk Singer' and touring the world.

With Isla's lively personality and sense of humour her career developed to encompass performing in and presenting award-winning shows on stage, radio and TV. When she co-hosted *The Generation Game* with Larry Grayson the series achieved audiences of 18 million viewers.

The combination of Isla's presentation skills and her beautiful singing voice makes this programme of songs, including bothy ballads from Scotland's north-east, an event which should not be missed.

The venue for the event will be The Caledonian Club, 9 Halkin Street, London, SW1X 7DR from 6.30pm with the music beginning promptly at 7.00pm. The cost of the event is £25 per person to include a warming helping of The Caledonian Club's delicious haggis, neeps & tatties. There will be a cash bar from 6:30 until 7:00, during the short interval and at the end of the evening.
